



### **Can I Still Register for uCamp?**

Absolutely! Spots are still available for uCamp26, and we'd love to have you join us this August for a week of camping, community, and fun. Visit [ucamp26.eventbrite.com](https://ucamp26.eventbrite.com) to reserve your spot today!

We offer two attendee ticket options depending on your camping setup:

1st Attendee — \$145\*

This ticket is for guests reserving their own campsite (campsite cost not included). It includes access to all uCamp events, activities, and meals throughout the week.

Additional Attendee — \$145\*

Staying with someone who already has a campsite? This ticket is required for each additional guest and includes access to all uCamp events, activities, and meals.

Dog Admission — \$10\*

Bringing your furry camping companion? Dog admission includes entry for one dog plus a small nuCamp gift. Service dogs are welcome free of charge. Please indicate your service animal in the accommodations section during registration.

\*Taxes and Eventbrite fees are not included.

### **How Do I Book My Campsite?**

Once you've completed your uCamp registration, we'll send your information directly to Atwood Lake Park. Their team will then contact you to finalize and book your campsite.

Atwood Lake Park offers four campsite options, and every site includes a designated parking space, picnic table, and fire ring. For more information visit their [website here](#). You can view the campground map [here](#).

Electric Only (Waterfront) — \$352\*

Full Hookups (Non-Waterfront) — \$406\*

Full Hookups (Waterfront) — \$514\*

The prices listed above reflect the recommended six-night stay so you can experience everything uCamp has to offer, including:

Check-in: Sunday, August 2 at 4 p.m.

Check-out: Saturday, August 8 at 2 p.m.

While a six-night stay is recommended to enjoy the full event experience, you are not required to stay the entire week. Please note that a minimum stay of four nights is required.

\*Campsite pricing is set by Atwood Lake Park and is subject to applicable taxes and fees.

### **What is the cancellation policy?**

You may cancel your uCamp entry ticket for a **full refund up to 30 days prior to the event (July 6)**. After that date, entry tickets are non-refundable. [Atwood Lake Park](#) has a separate cancellation policy and may offer partial refunds for campsites.

### **What events or activities will happen at uCamp?**

Our team is hard at work planning uCamp events. Expect fun-filled gatherings, hands-on learning opportunities, and plenty of chances to connect with the nuCamp community. From tech talks and RV tips to games, activities, and nightly campfires, there's never a dull moment at uCamp.

Attendees can look forward to two dinners, a hot breakfast, Amish Country donuts, and light breakfasts throughout the event. Plus, enjoy crowd favorites like cornhole tournaments, bingo, tie dye, and more! ### **What amenities are available at Atwood Lake Park?**

[Atwood Lake Park](#) offers a wide range of amenities to enhance your uCamp experience, including:

- Campsites with a picnic table and campfire ring
- Designated parking at each campsite
- Swimming beach with concession stand
- Picnic shelters
- Activity Center and Nature Center
- Hiking trails
- Free Wi-Fi at the Activity Center
- Laundry facilities and camp store
- Public restrooms and shower houses
- Two on-site restaurants
- Public boat launch ramps
- Dog park

### **Can I choose my campsite? Is there a map?**

Yes! You may either select your own campsite or have one assigned to you by Atwood Lake Park. You can view the map [here](#). When Atwood contacts you to book your site, simply let them know your preference.

Please remember: do not contact Atwood Lake Park to book your campsite in advance. They have a small team and will call attendees as their schedule allows.

### **What are the campsites like?**

**Area H:** The largest section with 142 full hookup sites, concrete pads, electric (50-amp, 30-amp, and 110v power), and parking. Includes lakefront views, a playground, restrooms, showers, laundry, and a pavilion with a fire pit. The trees here are small and do not provide shade, with some larger trees on the edges.

**Areas B & C / A & G:** Full hookups (50-amp, 30-amp, and 110v power) with concrete pads, restrooms, and showers. Minimal shade, with some larger trees on the edges.

**Area F:** 30-amp electric-only sites on grass or gravel. Includes a shower house, restrooms, and a dump station. Some trees provide shade.

**Areas E & D:** 30-amp electric-only sites on grass or gravel. No on-site restrooms or showers, but facilities are available in nearby Area B. Some trees provide shade. Dump station is nearby at the start of the F Loop.

### **Are pets allowed at uCamp?**

Yes — pets are welcome at uCamp! When purchasing your ticket, you may add a dog admission for \$10 (+ taxes and fees). Upon arrival, your pup will receive a special nuCamp gift.

By purchasing a dog admission, you agree to our [pet policy](#), which outlines guidelines to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all campers. Please be respectful of others, including those who may not be dog-friendly.

Service dogs are exempt from the admission fee. Please note this in the accommodations section during registration.

### **Is food provided?**

Yes! Several meals are included during uCamp. While the final menu is still being planned, meals typically include:

- Two group dinners
- One hot breakfast
- Light breakfasts and coffee on other days (excluding Monday)

The event schedule will clearly indicate which meals are provided so you can plan accordingly.

### **I have allergies or dietary restrictions. Can I still participate?**

Yes. During online registration, you will be asked to note any allergies or dietary needs, such as vegetarian, vegan, or gluten-free preferences.

We do our best to accommodate these requests; however, we cannot guarantee that all meals will meet specific dietary requirements. If you have severe allergies or strict dietary needs, we recommend bringing additional food options as a precaution.

### **Can I transfer my ticket to someone else if I cancel?**

No, uCamp tickets are non-transferable.

### **Will there be a Swap Meet?**

Yes, there will be a swap meet at uCamp26. If you'd like to be included in the guide book, please fill out a brief form [here](#). Please let us know what items you plan to bring to the swap meet by June 1.

You do not have to fill out the form to participate in the swap meet. If you decide to sell something last minute, no worries! Go ahead and bring it with you.

### **Can I schedule service?**

Yes, you can request service via our service request form, which will be shared with attendees on June 2 at 11 a.m. ET. Appointments will be available on a first-come, first-served basis at that time. After you submit the form, a team member will contact you to confirm your appointment.

#### On-Site Service from the nuCamp Service Center

There are limited types of service available at the campground. Available services include:

- MaxxAir Fan Upgrade
- Fan Installation or Upgrade
- Shade Replacement
- Window Replacement
- Light Replacement (Tail, Porch, Marker)
- Lagun Table Mount Install
- Tongue Jack Replacement
- Lock Install Exterior Baggage Door
- Drawer Adjustment

#### Off-Site Service at the nuCamp Service Center

If you are in need of service not listed above, we've reserved special appointment slots at our nuCamp Service Center in Sugarcreek, OH — just a short 35-minute drive from Atwood Lake Park. The following services require you to bring your camper to our Sugarcreek service center:

- Tongue Box Upgrade
- Wheel Bearing Maintenance
- Alde Glycol Flush & Fill

These dates have been set aside exclusively for uCamp attendees, giving you priority access to service while you're already in the area.

#### Available Appointment Dates:

- Week before uCamp: July 27 – July 31
- During uCamp: August 4 – 7
- Week after uCamp: August 10 – 14

#### On-Site Glycol Changes at the Campground

We're excited to partner with Truma North America, who will be offering on-site glycol changes at the campground during the event (August 3-7). Please be aware these appointments are limited, so if you are interested, we suggest submitting as soon as the form becomes available.

Important: Because on-site glycol changes are limited, if you are booking any services at the [nuCamp Service Center](#) in Sugarcreek, we ask that you also book your glycol through the service center.

### **Can I order parts?**

Yes, you can order parts for pickup during uCamp. More information will be available in July.
